Shou Sugi Ban, embracing the charred elegance of wood

The elegance of charred timber cladding can turn any design into a masterwork. Charred using ancient Shou Sugi Ban techniques, our claddings offer incredible performance and stunning aesthetics. Finished with a layer of natural char, Shou Sugi Ban timber cladding offers excellent protection against fires, storms and moisture.

Shou Sugi Ban is a special Japanese charring technique, inspired by an ancient tradition. This is how the facades of traditional Japanese wooden houses were given a fire retardant, sustainable, and natural protective layer. The treatment was introduced after Japan fell into a short supply of driftwood, collected from the coastlines for its prized appearance and durability; formed by a natural treatment process of saltwater, surf and sun.

Our fire masters individually char each length of timber in a controlled environment at our Moss Vale manufacturing facility. This way we can guarantee equal and uniform technical specifications.



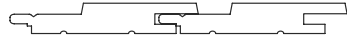

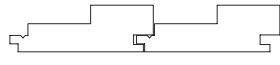

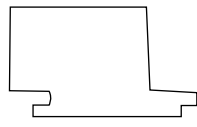

Sealer coating — Available with one coat of our signature sealer pre-applied with an additional coat required to be applied on-site once installed

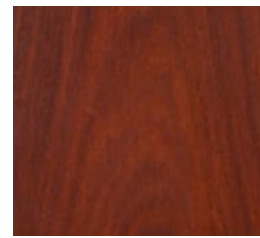

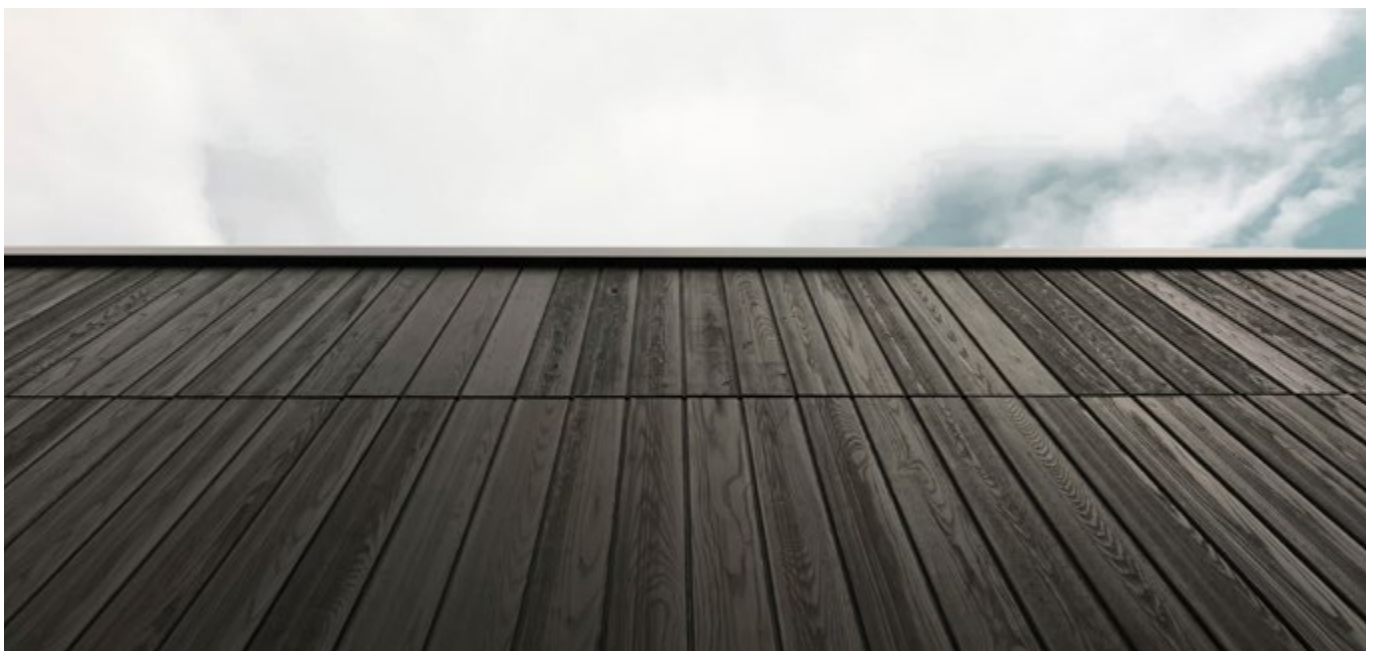

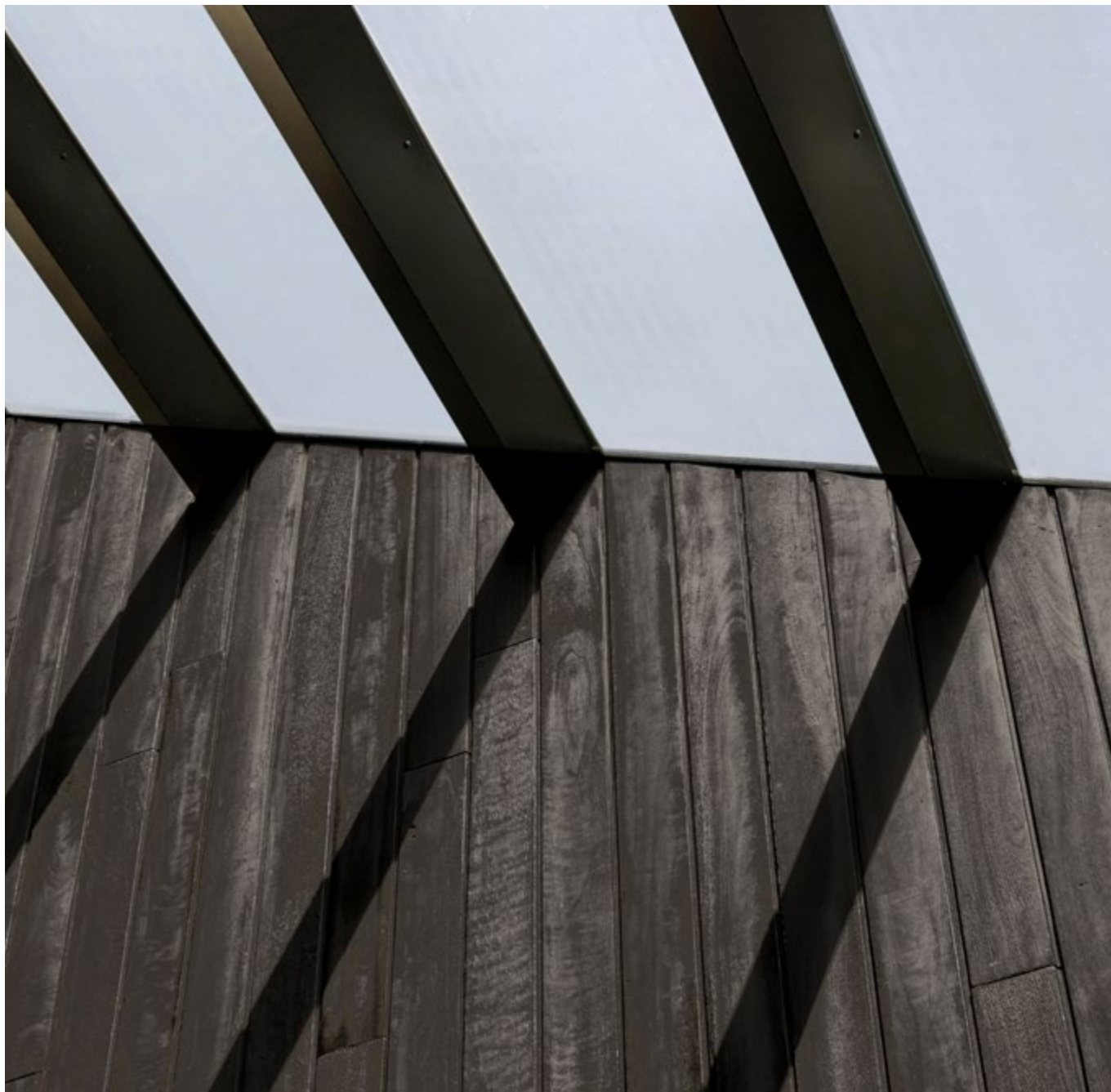

We are committed to manufacturing with zero waste from harvesting through to your completed product. During the harvesting process, all by-products such as sawdust, chips, and bark are sent to pulp and paper manufacturers, to create other sustainably sourced products. When moulding profiles, any other by-product is processed into a fine dust, used in organic soils.

With our commitment to achieving Net Zero emissions by 2050, we offer a range of cladding and lining solutions with an embodied energy as low as 0.5MJ/kg. All coatings used at Modinex are ultra-low VOC, taking our responsibility to reduce the concentration of contaminants in the ozone layer.

Charred timber is a strong, resilient, and low-maintenance timber style, often used in residential and commercial design due to its aesthetic appearance.

The deep charcoal colour along with the texture of the charring creates a unique timber profile. We combine old-fashioned craftsmanship with modern technology.
